Volunteer & Exhibitor Check-In:

Volunteer and Exhibitor Check-in leaders are among the first friendly faces our team and partners will meet. In this role, you'll help mark attendance, welcome volunteers, provide brief training, and guide exhibitors to their booths. Your warm greeting sets the tone for a great event!

Curiosity Concierge:

Curiosity Concierges are our friendly, go-to guides for families throughout the event. These volunteers help answer questions about the venue, point guests toward activities and demonstrations, and ensure everyone feels welcome and supported. With a warm smile and spirit of exploration, Curiosity Concierges help families navigate the event with ease and discover all the excitement waiting for them!

Demonstration Leader:

Demonstration Leaders will guide their own Mind Trekkers activity – no STEM experience is required! We provide all the supplies, instructions, and support you'll need. If you enjoy working directly with students and bringing hands-on learning to life, this role is a great fit for you!
